SEASONAL RECIPE

Pumpkin Soup

1 tablespoon olive oil	1 tablespoon curry powder (mild or medium, depending on your preference)
1 brown onion, coarsely chopped	1 cup of vegetable stock
1 garlic clove, crushed	½ cup of cream
2 teaspoons of ground cumin	Salt and cracked black pepper
2 teaspoons of ground coriander	
1 large-sized butternut pumpkin, skin and seeds removed and roughly chopped	

1. Heat oil in a large saucepan over medium-high heat. Add onion and garlic. Cook for a few minutes, stirring, or until soft and golden. Add cumin and coriander. Cook, stirring for 1 minute or until aromatic.
2. Add pumpkin and stir to coat. Add stock and curry powder. Bring to the boil, stirring occasionally. Simmer, partially covered, for 20 minutes or until the pumpkin is soft, stirring occasionally. Set aside to cool slightly.
3. Stir in cream and transfer to mixing bowl or blender. Blend until smooth or as desired. Season with salt and pepper.

MAINTENANCE

Who is Responsible if I Have a Break-In?

Random crime can occur even in the nicest neighborhoods. Generally, management takes responsibility for any damage to the building during a break-in; the property owner's insurance typically covers costs such as repairing a door or window. However, residents are responsible for their own belongings. That's one reason that management recommends renter's insurance for all occupants; that small monthly fee can ensure that your personal property is protected in the event of a burglary.

In order to take advantage of these protections, it's important that you follow certain procedures. For example, most insurance companies will require a police report before considering a claim based on a break-in, so you'll want to contact the police immediately. And, you'll need to contact management right away to determine what kind of information and paperwork is required.

Failing to take action, document the incident, report to law enforcement or provide required documentation could end up costing you money. And, you may be liable if your negligence caused the break-in, so be sure to follow your lease terms and take reasonable security precautions.
